



We thank the management and Principal profusely for providing the facilities and encouragement to do the workshop.

The proposal for this program was first suggested in a staff meeting, in the department of Public Health Dentistry. Our intention was to conduct a research program which would be a continuation of our first workshop on Health Research Methodology and Health Statistics. The workshop was designed to help every participant to apply the knowledge of basics of Health research and Health statistics into application through group activities. The idea was to practice the principle of 'Learning by Doing'. This can also drive the concepts of research methodology and biostatistics deep into the realm of 'Known' in the delegates.

The registration for the research program was first opened up to the faculty and PG students of our college, till 18th Jan 2019. Later, the brochure was sent through emails and whatsapp groups to the Heads of the Department, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry of other dental colleges in Karnataka. We had an overwhelming response from the staff of different specialties from our college, and around 10 staff from other dental colleges across Bangalore. One staff also from Rama Dental College, Kanpur attended the program. Around 55 postgraduates from the Department of Public Health Dentistry of different dental colleges in Karnataka also attended the research program and workshop. We stopped the


Out of 110 registered delegates, around 50 delegates were interns, PG students & staff members from our college & more than 50 from other colleges of Bangalore & Tumkur.



Each and every one of the delegates went home with eager minds to pen down their research works and to do further research with the skills that they had acquired in these 4 days.

The programme was a huge success, and this is a remarkable achievement for the Department of Public Health Dentistry, DSCDS, and for the DSI as a whole.

This time, we had developed a protocol, where the delegates had to give an exam before taking up the 2nd module. This time we collected feedback in an e-format for the lectures & the workshop conducted.

The study material for all the lectures of Modules 1 & 2 were mailed to all the delegates well in advance to facilitate learning &in a process of providing study material to the participants.

The surgical hands-on module was conducted from 8th -10th April 2019, which gave a wonderful hands-on training to all the delegates by making them place implants on dummy mandibles as well as on patients. This module was a coordinated effort of four departments: Departments of Oral Medicine and Radiology, Oral Surgery, Periodontics and Prosthodontics conducted with the help of renowned external resource persons Dr Vinayak Gowda and Dr.Deepak. 



2. Awareness rally near Lalbagh west gate




3. Health talk at NR colony, UPHC



Report on World No Tobacco Day Webinar 5th June 2021



The theme for this year is----"COMMIT **TO QUIT**". The Webinar was based on this theme and we invited distinguished speakers in the field of tobacco cessation **Dr Vikrant Mohanthy**, **Dr Ashwini and Ms**. **Shinon** from Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences, Delhi.







"Rotary Endodontics and Hands-on workshop"



MAXFAC PROSTHETICS- A HEALING ART


