
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ORAL HYGIENE DAY 2017




Out of 110 registered delegates, around 50 delegates were interns, PG students & staff members from our college & more than 50 from other colleges of Bangalore & Tumkur.


"Predictable Restorations with Direct Composites- Making the right choices"

They were also able to calculate sample size for a given research using G power soft ware and enter the dummy data into the excel sheet, import, analyze the data using SPSS and interpret the data.




The programme was a huge success, and this is a remarkable achievement for the Department of Public Health Dentistry, DSCDS, and for the DSI as a whole.







2. Awareness rally near Lalbagh west gate




3. Health talk at NR colony, UPHC

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


AHA CERTIFIED BASIC LIFE SUPPORT WORKSHOP-2019



Report on World No Tobacco Day Webinar 5th June 2021



"Understanding of the Revised Framework of NAAC"




