



Role and Responsibilities Of Hospital Infection Control Committee

The infection control committee functions to prevent and control aid-associated infections by setting infection control policy and observance practices to scale back these risks.

THE VITAL FUNCTIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Basic measures i.e normal and extra precautions
- Education and coaching of healthcare employees
- Protection of healthcare workers for instance immunisation
- Identification of hazards and minimizing risks
- Routine practices equivalent to sterile techniques, handling and use of blood and blood products, waste management, use of single use devices.
- Incident monitoring analysis

INFECTION MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The hospital independent agency is charged with the responsibility for planning, analysis of proven – based practise and implementation, prioritization and resource allocation of all matters about infection management.

The ICC should have a direct relationship on to either administration or the medical employees to market infection control programme visibility and effectiveness.

The ICC ought to meet frequently (monthly) in line with native need.

THE COMMITTEE SHOULD INCLUDE-

1. Chair govt or hospital administrator
2. Hospital life scientist
3. Infection control nurse
4. Health Physician
5. Representative from the most important clinical specialities
6. further representatives of the other department.

Team should have authority to manage an efficient management programme.

Team should have a direct relationship with senior administration

Infection control team members or are chargeable for every day functions of ICC and making ready the yearly work plan.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ICC

To develop an annual infection control plan with clearly outlined objective

To develop written policies and procedures as well as regular analysis and update

To supervise and monitor daily practices of patient care designed to forestall infection.

To make sure availability of acceptable provides

To arrange associate degree medicine police investigation programme

To teach all grades of employees in infection management policy, follow and procedures.



SCOPE OF INFECTION

Management normal precautions:

These measures should be applied throughout each patient care, during exposure to any infected material or body fluids, blood and others parts

Hand laundry

Barrier precautions

Sharp disposal

Handling of contaminated material.
