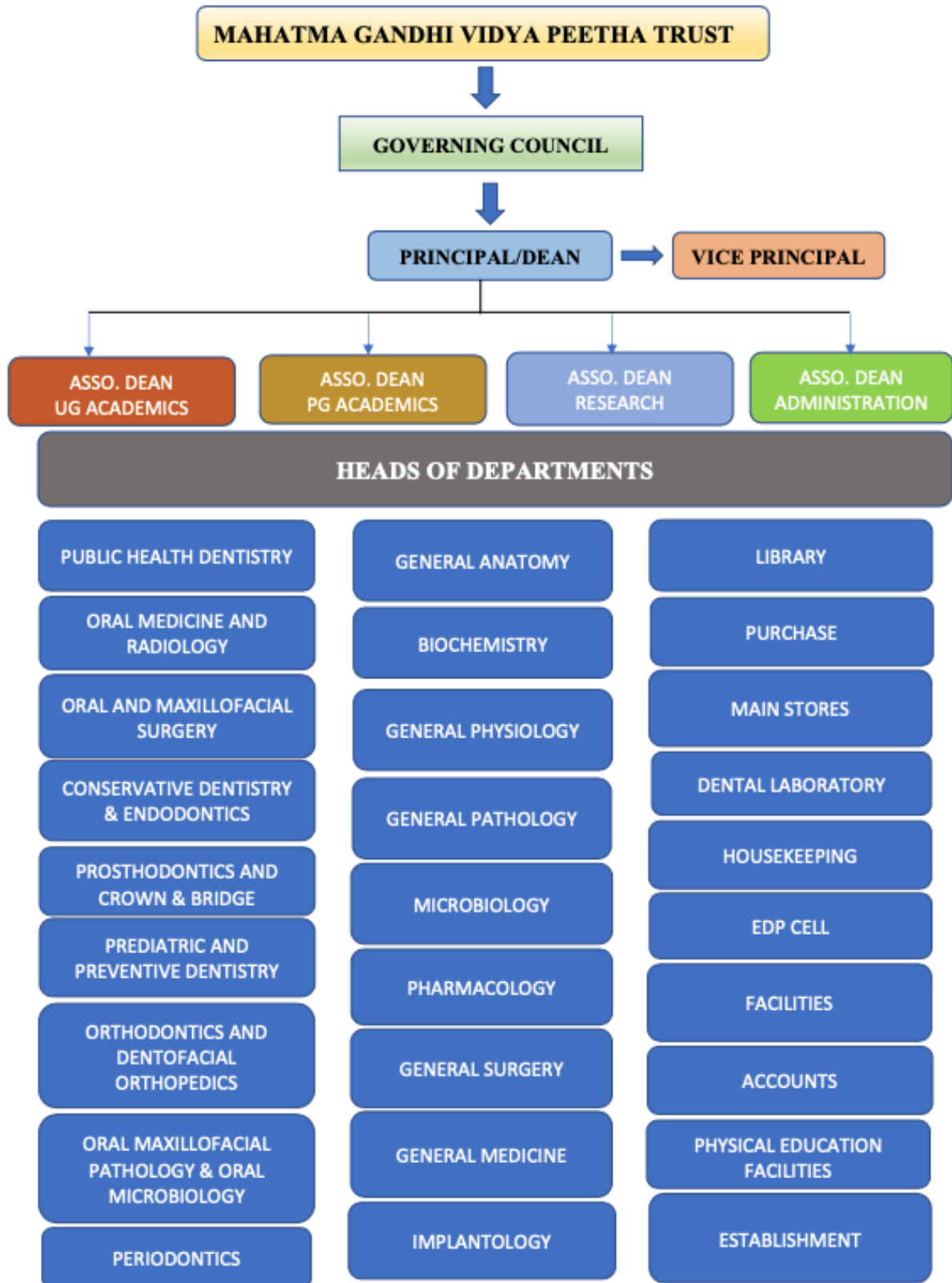

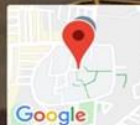
## **WOMEN'S ORAL HEALTH -OUR CONCERN ON 17-03-2022**

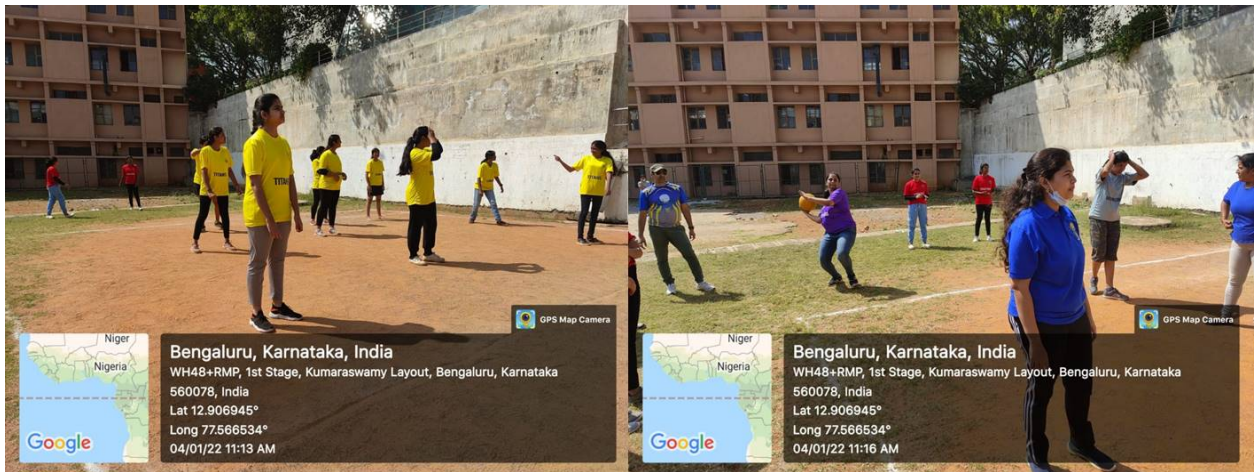

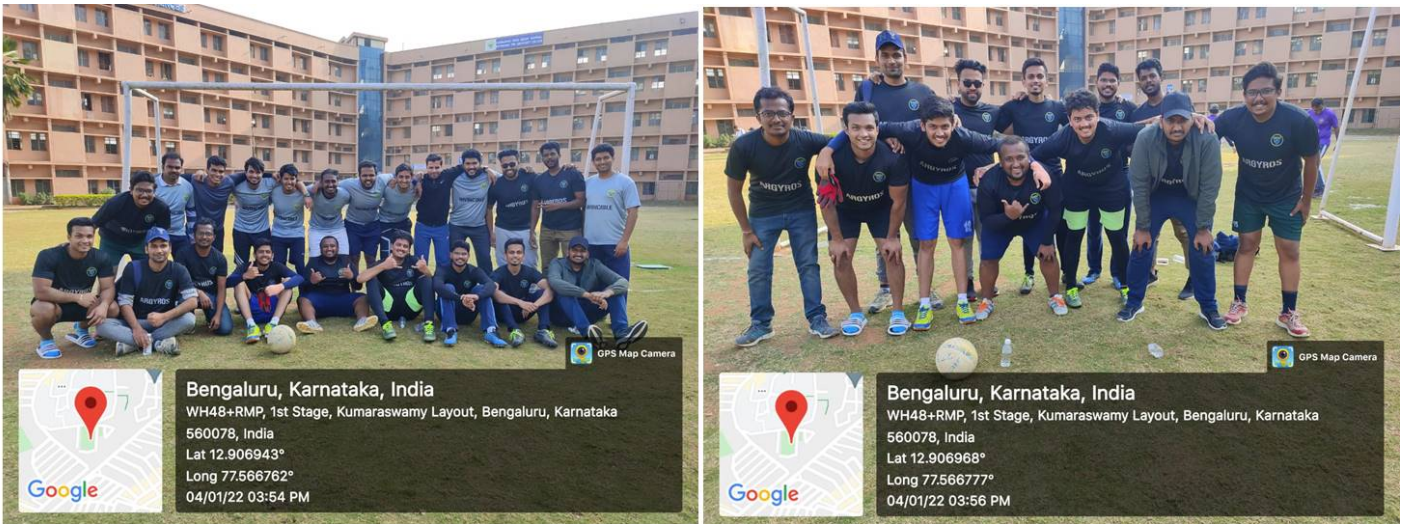
