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





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




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#### WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY -MAY 315 2024

AND: Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences (herein referred to as 'The Secondary Party') whose address is Shavige Malleshwara Hills, Kumaraswamy Layout, Bangalore 560 078 (which expression shall unless repugnant to be context or meaning there of be deemed to mean and include their successors, executors, administrators and permitted assigns) of the other part.

WHEREAS Commissioner, Health and Family Welfare Services, Government of Karnataka (GoK), is the Competent Authority at State level to implement various Programmes and Schemes of the Health & Family Welfare Services and shall implement the Oral Health Policy to provide complete/Partial Dentures to the needy citizens (45 years and above) who live below poverty line and this part of the policy shall be herein called as "Danta Bhagya Yojane".

WHEREAS Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences, located at Kumaraswamy Layout established in the year 1991-92 has professional, academic and technical proficiency in implementing the scheme "Danta Bhagya Yojane" and henceforth has agreed to provide the technical support and treatment for providing the complete dentures to the needy senior citizens who live below poverty line.

AND WHEREAS Commissioner, Health and Family Welfare Services, Government of Karnataka, and Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences recognize the necessity to synergize and mutually co-operate to provide removable complete/Partial Dentures to the needy citizens who live below poverty line in Karnataka and thereby to effectively implement the scheme of "Danta Bhagya Yojane" as part of the Oral Health Policy.

NOW THERFORE, this MoU hereby bestows the covenants in terms of certain roles and responsibilities for the parties for the smooth functioning of the "Danta Bhagya Yojane" and other schemes of Oral Health Policy as and when announced by the First Party.

## Responsibilities of Commissioner, Health and Family Welfare Services, Government of Karnataka: [FIRST PARTY]

- Health & Family Welfare Department shall implement the scheme of Danta Bhagya Yojane" in 30 Districts of Karnataka through the Government& Private Dental Colleges of Karnataka and District and Sub divisional Hospitals.
- Eligibility criteria for identifying the beneficiaries, referring to the nearby facility shall be made by the Health & Family Welfare Department.
- 3. Health & Family Welfare Department shall pay an amount flat Rs. 2000 (Rupees two thousandsOnly) per complete denture and Rs 1000 (Rupees One thousands only) per

Partial denture to the Dental College and District Hospitals & Sub divisional Hospitals (Mean and include their successors, executors, administrators and permitted assigns of the first part.). Which includes the cost of treatment plan, manpower, materials, technical services, and other incidental expenses.

- Health & Family Welfare Department shall provide the format for referral slips and monthly reports to all the concerned Institutions.
- 5. The Dental Officer/Medical Officer working at any State-run Government Health Centre/Government Hospital shall ONLY authorize the beneficiaries to avail the benefits of the scheme after scrutinizing the necessary documents. This does not include the Health Centers/Hospitals run by the Central Government.
- The payments to the Colleges shall be made into their bank accounts on a monthly
  basis after submitting their monthly report and invoice through treasury.
- Health & Family Welfare Department shall train the ANM's/ASHA's/paramedical
  personnel within their jurisdictional District to identify diagnose and refer the
  beneficiaries to the referring Dental Surgeons.

#### Responsibilities of the Dental College: [SECOND PARTY]

- Dental College shall conduct dental outreach camps in association with concerned
  District Dental Nodal Officers and District Health authorities to select the
  beneficiaries. Shall follow the Covid 19 Guidelines for Dental Procedure issued by
  the Government of India and Government of Karnataka.
- 2. Dental College shall not charge any kind of additional fees such as OPD card charges or registration fees, etc. The scheme does not include the cost of drugs, medications and other incidental expenses related to the complete/Partial dentures. However, any beneficiary having a few remaining teeth indicated for total extraction or any other minor procedures indicated as treatment plan for insertion of complete/partial dentures shall be free of cost including tooth extractions.
- Complete/Partial dentures shall be made using standard treatment procedures and materials.
- 4. The Dental College shall not deny or delay treatment for the eligible beneficiaries of this scheme. However, the beneficiaries can be allotted appointment on first-cum-first serve basis and preferably on fixed days of the month to avoid undue delay of treatment.

- The Dental College shall treat the beneficiaries of this scheme as its own patient and take all necessary measures such as informed consent.
- The Dental College shall submit their monthly reports to the District Health & Family
  Welfare Officer and Deputy Director (Oral Health Policy and Dental Health)
  periodically as agreed by both the parties.
- Beneficiaries of this project must be referred to dental colleges only by Dental Officer/Medical Officer working at any State-run Government Health Centre/Government Hospital.

#### The parties agree as follows:

- Term: The Project implementation will commence on signing of MOU. The term of
  this Memorandum of Understanding is for a period of Five years and may be renewed
  unless terminated within the terms of this agreement under clause 15 and further
  subject to satisfactory performance and decision of the GoK.
- 2. Financial provisions and management of funds: All the payments for project activities will be paid directly to the Second party/Dental College upon timely submission of their monthly reports to the District Health & Family Welfare Officer and Deputy Director (Oral Health Policy and Dental Health) periodically as agreed by both the parties The payments to the Colleges shall be made into their bank accounts on a monthly basis after submitting their monthly report and invoice through treasury.
- 3. The Second Party shall not make any changes without prior approval from the Commissioner, Health & Family Welfare Department, and Government of Karnataka. Changes in the line item shall not after the main purpose of the project and shall be done only to ensure smooth implementation of the agreed project goal.
- Statutory liabilities such as TDS (Tax deduction at Source), Professional Tax, etc will be the responsibility of the Member Secretary, Oral Health Policy, and the deductions will be made accordingly as applicable.
- 5. Visibility: The second party must take all necessary steps to publicize the fact that the Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Karnataka, has financed the activities funded under this scheme. The Health and Family Welfare Department. Government of Karnataka, shall acknowledge the second party for its effort and technical support in implementing the project.

#### Second Part

WHEREAS, The NIMHANS is providing comprehensive medical care facilities to Employees/Pensioners and their dependent family members.

AND WHEREAS, NIMHANS HEALTH SCHEME (NHS) proposes to provide treatment facilities in Allopathy to the NHS beneficiaries in the Private Recognized Hospitals/Centers.

AND WHEREAS DAYANANDA SAGAR COLLEGE OF DENTAL SCIENCES Hospital/Centre offered to give the treatment to the NHS Beneficiaries who may produce a permission letter from their NIMHANS HEALTH CENTRE.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED between the Parties as follows:

#### 1. DEFINITIONS & INTERPRETATIONS

- 1.1 The following terms and expressions shall have the following meanings for purposes of this Agreement:
- "Agreement" shall mean this Agreement and all Schedules, supplements, appendices, 1.1.1 appendages and modifications thereof made in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
- "Benefit" shall mean the extent or degree of service the beneficiaries are entitled to 1.1.2 receive as per the rules on the subject.
- 1.1.3 "Card" shall mean the NHS Card. Issued by any competent authority of NIMHANS.
- "Card Holder" shall mean a person having a NHS Card. 1.1.4
- "NHS Beneficiary" shall mean a person who is eligible for coverage of NHS and hold a valid 1.1.5 NHS card for the benefit.
- "Coverage" shall mean the hospital/diagnostic center authorized by the NIMHANS for HEALTH 1.1.6 SCHEME.
- "Empanelment' shall mean the hospital/diagnostic center authorized by the NIMHANS for 1.1.7 treatment purposes for a particular period.
- 'Hospital' shall mean the DAYANANDA SGAR COLLEE OF DENTAL SCIENCES while performing 1.1.8 under this Agreement providing medical investigation, treatment and the Healthcare of
- 1.1.9 ¿ 'Recognition of Hospital' shall mean the Hospital empanelled by the NHS for a particular period for providing realment facilities and projectives etc. to the NHS beneficeries at the rules laid down.
- 1.1.10 'De-recognition of Hospital" shall mean debarring the hospital on account of adopting unethical practices or fraudulent means in providing medical treatment to or not following the good industry practices of the health care for the NHS beneficiaries after following certain procedure of inquiry.
- 1.1.11 "Party" shall mean either the NIMHANS or the Hospital/Centre and "Party" shall mean both the NIMHANS and the Hospital/Diagnostic Centre.
- 1.1.12 (a)"Package Rate" means rates for a package of treatment of standard set of procedures that administered to the patient while undergoing treatment for a pre-diagnosed diseasecondition for the specified time period.



- This includes all charges pertaining to a particular treatment/procedure including registration charges, admission charges, accommodation charges, cost of medicines, Panchakarma charges, Labour Room Charges, Charges for Ksharasutra, operation/procedure charges, doctor/consultant visit charges, monitoring charges, operation theatre charges and cost of all sundries used during hospitalization, related routine investigations, physiotherapy charges etc. form the time of admission till discharge. This also is inclusive of all sub-procedures and all related procedures to complete the treatment.
- No additional charge on account of extended period shall be allowed if that extension is due to any improperly conducted procedure.
- 1.1.13 "Bill Clearing Agency" (BCA means the agency appointed by NIMHANS for processing of Data/Bills of all NHS beneficiaries (both serving and pensioner) attending the empanelled private Hospitals and for making payment.

#### 2. SERVICE AREA

The Hospital/Diagnostic Centre shall provide treatment facilities to the NHS beneficiaries who may produce a permission letter from NIMHANS HEALTH CENTRE (NHC).

#### 3. SERVICE CHARGES

The Hospital/Center shall charges from the NHS beneficiaries as per the rates for a particular procedure/ package deal as prescribed by the CGHS which shall be an integral part of this Agreement. This also includes the ward entitlement as per CGHS rules. It further includes description of General ward, semiprivate ward, private ward as per CGHS norms.

#### 4. DURATION

The Agreement shall remain in force for a period of 2 years or till it is modified or revoked, whichever is earlier. The Agreement may be extended for subsequent periods as required by NIMHANS subject to fulfillment of all the terms and conditions of this Agreement and with mutual consent.

#### 5. MEDICAL AUDIT OF BILLS

The medical audit of the bills of the hospital/center will be conducted by the NIMHANS or any authority designated by NIMHANS or the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare for that purpose within 90 days of discharge of the NHS beneficiary, as the case may be, from Hospital.

#### REVISION OF RATES

In case the notified rates are revised by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare after empanelment and such revised rates are not acceptable to the empanelled hospital/center no longer whishes to continue on the list empanelled hospitals/centers, it can apply for exclusion from the panel by giving three months notice and by depositing an exit fee equivalent to the average monthly bill submitted by it to the NIMHANS in the preceding one year.

#### 7. TREATMENT IN EMERGENCY

In emergency the hospital shall not refuse admission or demand an advance payment from the beneficiary or his family member and shall provide credit facilities to the patient whether the patient is a serving employee or a pensioner availing NHS facilities, on production of a valid NHS card within 24 hrs and the hospital shall submit the bill to BCA. The refusal to provide the treatment to bonafide NHS beneficiaries in emergency cases without valid ground, would attract disqualification for continuation of empanelment.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 8.1 All investigations regarding fitness for the surgery will be done prior to the admission for any elective procedure and are part of package. For any material/ additional procedure / investigation other than the condition for which the patient was initially permitted, would require the permission of the competent authority.
- 8.2 The package rate will be calculated as per the duration specified in the tender document under the "treatment requirements". No additional charge on account of extended period of stay shall be allowed if that extension is due to infection on the consequences of surgical procedure or due to any improper procedure and is not justified.
- 8.3 The rate being charged will not be more than what is being charges for same procedure from other (CGHS, non-CGHS and non Central Govt.) patient s or institutions. An authenticated list of rates being charged from other non-CGHS, non-Central Govt. Institutions if available will also be supplied within 10 days of this agreement.
- 8.4 The procedure and package rates for any procedure and other medical treatment for NHS beneficiary under this Agreement shall not be increased during the validity period of this Agreement.
- **8.5** The empanelled Hospital/Centre shall provide services only for which it has been empanelled at rates that will be fixed from time to time and shall be binding.
- 8.6 The Hospital will intimate all instances of patients admitted on the basis of the Authority letter issued by the NHS authorities in the prescribed format within one working day through fax/email (the number of which shall be notified ) followed by post.
- 8.7 The Hospital /Centre shall provide reports on monthly basis by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the succeeding calendar month in the prescribed format to the NIMHANS in respect of the beneficiaries treated.
- 8.8 The Hospital/Center agrees that any liability arising due to any default or negligence in providing or performance of the medical services shall be borne exclusively by the hospital/center who shall alone be responsible for the defect and /or deficiencies in rendering such services.
- 8.9 The Hospital agrees that during the in-patient treatment of the NHS beneficiary, the Hospital will not ask the beneficiary or his attendant to purchase separately the medicines/sundries/equipment or accessories from outside and will provide the treatment within the package deal rate, which includes the cost of all the items. Appropriate action, including removing from NHS empanelment and / or Termination of this Agreement, may be initiated on the basis of a complaint, medical audit or inspections carried out by NHS teams
- 8.10 On production of a valid permission by the NHS/beneficiaries, the hospital/center shall provide (credit facilities to the NHS beneficiaries after verifying the photo in the card. The NIMHANS is not liable to pay in cases of impersonation or treatment of ineligible persons.
- 8.11 The Hospital/Centre will submit an annual report regarding number of referrals received, admitted, bills submitted to the NHS and payment received.
- 8.12 Authorized signatory/representative of the hospital/center shall attend the periodic meetings held by Director, NIMHANS.
- 8.13 The Hospital/Diagnostic Centre will not make any commercial publicity projecting the name of NIMHANS. However, the fact of empanelment under NHS shall be displayed at the premises of the empanelled center, indicating that the charges will be as per CGHS approved rates.
- 8.14 The hospital will investigate/treat the NHS beneficiary patient only for the condition for which they are referred with permission, and in the specialty and / or purpose for which they are approved by NHS.
- 8.15 The Hospital shall not undertake treatment of referred cases in the system of medicine for which it is not empanelled.
- 8.16 The hospital will not refer the patient to other specialist / other hospital without prior permission of NIMHANS. Prior intimation shall be given by the NHS whenever patient needs further referral.
- 8.17 The rates notified by GGHS shall be available on web site of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare Govt. of India at www.spotfw.nic.in.

### 9. SUBMISSION OF BILLS TO BILL CLEARING AGENCY

The Hospital/Centre shall submit the bills of the NHS beneficiaries both electronically as well as physically to the BCA for processing the same for payment.

#### Payment within twenty days:

NIMHANS shall appoint a Bill Clearing Agency (BCA), for processing of Data / Bills of all NHS beneficiaries attending these Hospitals, NIMHANS would ensure that payment of hospital claims would be done in time bound manner – within a period of 20 working days from the date of submission of bills in physical format / complete information related to the claim to the designated BCA.

#### NHS beneficiary attending hospital:

In such a situation the Hospital shall intimate to BCA within 2 hours of admission and BCA shall respond in 4 working hours (however treatment shall not be denied to any NHS member and this is only an initiation of the e-workflow). Post discharge, hospital would upload bills and download documents as per requirements of NHS within 96 hours.

#### Infrastructure for interaction with BCA

The Hospital shall have:

Dedicated personal Computer with Dual Core /core 2 DUO processor and minimum 2 GB RAM supported by UPS. OS should be Windows. Dedicated Colour scanner with a minimum resolution 200dpi. Scalable Broad Band Internet connectivity with minimum assured speed of 512 kbps.

Necessary security systems should be taken care of A designated Nodal Person to interact with BCA The Private Hospital would be legally responsible for user authentication.

#### Processing of Claims / Bills by BCA:-

The actual auditing shall start when physical copies containing complete information of these bills are submitted by concerned Hospital to the BCA on behalf of the NIMHANS.

The BCA during the course of the auditing shall restrict the claims as per CGHS rules and regulations. BCA shall also examine in terms of the following:

- \* Appropriateness of treatment including screening of patients records to identify unnecessary admissions and unwarranted treatments.
- \* Whether the planned treatment is shown as emergency treatment
- \* Whether the diagnostic medical or surgical procedures that were not required were conducted by hospital including unnecessary investigations.
- \* Maintaining database of such information of NHS beneficiaries for future use.
- \* whether the treatment procedures have been provided as per the approved rates and the packages.
- \*Whether procedures performed were only those for which permission has been granted.

The BCA shall record their findings and intimate the same to the Hospital concerned with a copy endorsed to NIMHANS. The payment of the bill / claim to the hospital concerned shall be made directly by NIMHANS after receipt of the bills which are duly adjudicated by the BCA.

The Hospital / Centre is required to pay processing fee to the bill the mine agency. The processing Fee is as under:

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF HOSPITALS / CENTERS

It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Hospital / Centre, at all times, to obtain, maintain and sustain the valid registration, recognition and high quality and standard of its services and health care and to have all statutory / mandatory licenses, permits or approvals of the concerned authorities under or as per the existing laws.


#### 11. NON ASSIGNMENT

The hospital / centre shall not assign, in whole or in part, its obligations to perform under the agreement, except with the NIMHANS's prior written consent at its sole discretions and on such terms and conditions as deemed fit by the NIMHANS. Any such assignment shall not relieve the Hospital / Centre from any liability or obligation under this agreement.

12. HOSPITAL'S / CENTER'S INTEGRIT AND OBIGATIONS DURING AGREEMENT PERIOD THE Hospital's / Centre is responsible for and obliged to conduct all contracted activities in accordance with the Agreement using state- of -the -art methods and economic principles and exercising all means available to achieve the performance specified in the Agreement. The Hospital / Centre is obliged to act within its own authority and abide by the directives issued by the NIMHANS. The Hospital / Centre is responsible for managing the activities of its personnel and will hold itself responsible for their misdemeanors, negligence, misconduct or deficiency in services, if any.

#### 13. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

- 13.1 The Hospital / Diagnostic Centre shall provide the services as per the requirements specified by the NIMHANS in terms of the provisions of this Agreement. In case of initial violation of the provisions of the agreement by the Hospital / Centre such as refusal of service or direct charging from the NHS Beneficiaries or defective service and negligence, in the first instance, the complaint will be examined by the NIMHANS authorities and if the complaint is found to be true the NIMHANS shall have the right to give a show cause notice to the Hospital to be replied within 10 days of its receipt, and the reply of the Hospital will be examined by a standing committee ) constituted for the purpose of deciding the appropriateness of the treatment or diagnostic procedures, as the case maybe. If the Committee concludes that the Hospital / Diagnostic Centre has violated the provisions of the Agreement necessary action will be taken for de-recognition of that Hespital. The decision of the MIMHANS will be final.
- 13.2 For over- billing and unnecessary procedures, the extra amount so charged will be deducted from the pending / future bills of the Hospital / Diagnostic Centre and the NIMHANS shall have the right to issue a written warning to the Hospital / Centre not to do so in future. The recurrence, if any, will lead to stoppage of referral to the Hospital / Diagnostic Centre.



### 14. TREATMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 14.1 The NIMHANS May, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Agreement, by written notice of default sent to the Hospital / Centre terminate the Agreement in whole or part:

  - If the Hospital / Centre fails to provide any or all of the services for which it has been recognized within the period (s) specified in the Agreement, or within any extension thereof if granted by the NIMHANS as the case may be, pursuant to Condition of Agreement, or If the Hospital / Center fails to perform any other obligation (s) under the Agreement.
  - c) If the Hospital / Center in the Judgment of the NIMHANS has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Agreement.
- 14.2 If the hospital/center found to be involved in or associated with any unethical illegal or unlawful activities, the Agreement will be summarily suspended by NIMHANS without any notice and thereafter may terminate the Agreement, after giving a show cause notice and considering its reply if any, received within 10 days of the receipt of show cause notice.
- 14.3 In case of any violation of the provisions of the Agreement by the Hospital/Center such as ( but not limited to ), refusal of service, refusal of credit facilities to eligible beneficiaries and direct charging from the NHS beneficiaries, undertaking unnecessary procedures, prescribing unnecessary drugs / tests, deficient or defective service, over billing and negligence in treatment, the NIMHANS shall have the right to de-recognize the hospital/center as the case may be.

#### 15. INDEMNITY

The hospital / Center shall at all times, indemnify and keep indemnified NIMHANS against all actions, suits, claims and demands brought or made against it in respect of anything done or purported to be done by the Hospital / Center in execution of or in connection with the services under this Agreement and against any loss or damage to NIMHANS consequent to any action or suit being brought against the NIMHANS along with (or otherwise), Hospital / Center as a party for anything done or purported to be done in the course of the execution of this Agreement. The Hospital /Diagnostic Center will at all times abide by the job safety measures and other statutory requirements prevalent in India and will keep free and indemnify the NIMHANS from all demands or responsibilities arising from accidents or loss of life, the cause or result of which is the Hospital / Center negligence or misconduct.

The Hospital / Center will pay all indemnities arising from such incidents without any extra cost to NIMHANS and will not hold the NIMHANS responsible or obligated. The NIMHANS may at its discretion and shall always be entirely at the cost of the Hospital Center defend such suit, either jointly with the Hospital / Center or singly in case the latter chooses not to defend the case.

#### PAYMENT

The payment will be made to the Hospital / Center within a period of 20 days from the date of submission of the bill accompanied with all necessary and supporting document. This clause should be read with clause Number 09.

#### 17. MISCELLANEOUS

- 17.1 Nothing under this Agreement shall be construed as establishing or creating between the parties any relationship of Master and Servant or Principal and Agent between the NIMHANS and the Hospital /Center.
- 17.2 The Hospital / Center shall not represent or hold itself out as agent of the NIMHANS.
- 17.3 The NIMHANS will not be responsible in any way for any negligence or misconduct of the Hospital / Center and its employees for any accident, injury or damage sustained or suffered by any NHS beneficiary or any third party resulting from or by any operation conducted by and on behalf of the Hospital / Center or in the course of doing its work or perform their duties under this Agreement or otherwise.

- The Hospital/Center shall notify the Government of any material change in their status and their shareholdings or that of any Guarantor of the Hospital / Center in particular Where such change would have an impact on the performance of obligation under this Agreement.
- 17.5. This agreement can be modified or altered only on written agreement signed by both the parties.
- 17.6. Should the hospital get wound up, partnership is dissolved, the NIMHANS shall have the right to terminate the Agreement. The termination of Agreement shall not relieve the hospital or their heirs and legal representatives from the liability in respect of the services provided by the Hospital during the period when the Agreement was in force.
- 17.7. The Hospital shall bear all expenses incidental to the preparation and stamping of this agreement.

#### 18. NOTICES:

18.1 Any notice given by one party to the other pursuant to this Agreement shall be sent to other party in writing by registered post or by facsimile and confirmed by copy post the other party's address as below.

# AGREEEMENT BETWEEN URRAO SATELLITE CENTRE AND

#### DAYANANDA SAGAR COLLEGE OF DENTAL SCIENCES, KUMARASWAMY LAYOUT, BANGALORE

#### AND

DAYANANDA SAGAR COLLEGE OF DENTAL SCIENCES, SHAVIGE MALLESHWARA HILLS, KUMARASWAMY LAYOUT, BANGALORE 560078 hereinafter called the Hospital of the Second Part. WHEREAS, the Contributory Health Service Scheme (CHSS) Department of Space ISRO, administered through U R Rao Satellite Centre (URSC) is providing comprehensive medical care facilities to the beneficiaries.

AND WHEREAS, Contributory Health Service Scheme hereinafter called CHSS proposes to provide treatment facilities to the Beneficiaries in the Private Recognized Hospital in Bangalore.

AND WHEREAS, DAYANANDA SAGAR COLLEGE OF DENTAL SCIENCES, KUMARASWAMY LAYOUT, BANGALORE 560078 offered to give the following treatment/diagnostic facilities to the Contributory Health Service Scheme Beneficiaries.

Dental Treatment

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED between the Parties as follows:

#### 1. DEFINITIONS & INTERPRETATIONS

- 1.1 The following terms and expressions shall have the following meanings for purpose of this Agreement:
  - 1.1.1 "Agreement" shall mean this Agreement and all Schedules, supplements, appendices, appendages and modifications thereof made in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
  - 1.1.2 "Benefit" shall means the extent or degree of service the beneficiaries are entitled to receive as per the rules on the subject.
    - 1.1.3 "Card" shall mean the CHSS Card, issued by URSC/ISRO.
    - 1.1.4 "Beneficiary" shall mean a person who is eligible for coverage of CHSS and hold a valid CHSS card for the benefit.
    - 1.1.5 "Hospital" shall mean the Columbia Asia Hospital, Sarjapur Road, Bangalore performing tests / investigations X-ray etc.
    - 1.1.6 "Emergency" shall mean any condition or symptom resulting from any cause, arising suddenly and if not treated at the early convenience, be detrimental to the health of the patient or will jeopardize the life of the patient.
      - 1.1.7 "Recognition of Hospital" shall mean the Hospital empanelled for a particular period for providing treatment facilities and procedures etc., to the beneficiaries at the rates appended to this agreement.

- 1.1.8 "De-recognition of Hospital" shall mean debarring the hospital on account of adopting unethical practices or fraudulent means in providing medical treatment to or not following the good industry practices of the health care for the CHSS beneficiaries after following certain procedure of inquiry.
- 1.1.9 "Party" shall mean either URSC or the Hospital and "Parties" shall mean both URSC and Hospital.
- 1.1.10 "Specialized treatment" shall mean the treatment in a particular speciality.
- 1.1.11 "Accounts Officer" shall mean the Officer authorized by URSC to process the medical bills, reimbursement claims or to carry out medical audit.
- 1.1.12 "Rates" Shall mean the CHSS Schedule of Rates.
- 1.1.13 "Competent Authority" shall mean the authority to whom the powers delegated as such from time to time at URSC & DOS as per the CHSS Scheme.
  - 1.2 Following Annexures shall be deemed to be an integral part of this Agreement.
    - 1. Refferal Letter (Form No.15) specimen-Annexure I
    - List of Accounts Officers for sending Bills for payment Annexure II
    - 3. CHSS SOR Annexure III.

#### 2. DURATION

The Agreement shall remain in force for a period of 2 years or till it is modified or revoked, whichever is earlier. The agreement may be extended for subsequent periods as required by URSC, subject to fulfillment of all the terms and conditions of this Agreement and with mutual consent.

### 3. REVISION OF RATES

In case the notified rates are revised by URSC after empanelment and such revised rates are not acceptable to the empanelled hospital, or for any other reason, the hospital no longer wishes to continue on the list of empanelled hospitals, it can apply for exclusion from the panel by giving three months notice.

### 4. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 4.1 The rate being charged shall not be more than what is being charged for same procedure from other (non-CHSS) patients or institutions. An authenticated list of rates being charged for other non-CHSS institutions shall be forwarded to URSC within 10 days of this Agreement.
- 4.2 The empanelled Hospital shall provide services only for which it has been empanelled by URSC at rates fixed.
- 4.3 The Hospital agrees that any liability arising due to any default or negligence in providing or performance of the medical services shall be borne exclusively by the hospital centre which shall alone be responsible for the defect and / or deficiencies in rendering such services.
- 4.4 On production of a valid referral letter by the beneficiary, the hospital shall provide credit facilities to the beneficiary after verifying the photo in the CHSS card, URSC is not liable to pay in cases of impersonation or treatment of ineligible persons.
- 4.5 In case of any change in the infrastructure, the same shall be informed to URSC.

- 4.6 Authorized representative of the hospital shall attend the periodic meeting held by URSC required in connection with improvement of functioning of the Scheme.
- 4.7 The Hospital shall not make any commercial publicity projecting the empanelment of the Hospitals under this scheme.
- 4.8 The Hospital shall on completion of the treatment obtain the signature of the prime beneficiary on the final bill in token of verification. A copy of the bill shall be handed over to the beneficiary.
- 4.9 The Hospital shall not charge any extra amount from the beneficiary towards consumables used for procedures and for any treatment/procedures included in the Schedule of Rates(SOR).
- 4.10 <u>Additional Instructions</u>: As per DOS letter No.11012/5/2015-V dated 20.03.2015, the following instructions are to be followed for Dental treatment and Dental procedure in addition to the earlier instructions. The below instructions are to be complied with strictly.
  - a) Number of fillings in a single sitting not to exceed 3.
  - b) On a single sitting, crowning should be done on one side and not to exceed 4.
  - c) Two procedures like gingival surgery and gingivoplasty should not be done on the same side on the same day. In the claim form, precise procedure name should be used, rather than using generic terms like gingivoplasty/gingival surgery.
  - d) Whether a full mouth gingival procedure is done, it should be done dividing the mouth into 4 quadrants and not 6.

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- e) Multiple crowns are done in one sitting. This is not practiced usually. This may be a bridge work which is essentially a fixed partial denture. Splitting the bills as multiple crowns may be camouflage for fixed partial denture.
- f) Billing may be done for admissible procedures only and not for inadmissible procedures.

# 5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE HOSPITAL

- 5.1 The Hospitals should be professionally managed, well equipped and should be adequately staffed with qualified medical, paramedical and other personnel.
- 5.2 The Hospital should provide all necessary preventive, therapeutic, surgical or other services as may be required for beneficiaries.
- 5.3 The Hospital shall raise bills for payment only in terms of the rates specified in the Annexure to this contract.
- 5.4 The Hospital shall provide a monthly report in digital format to the Chief Medical Officer, URSC giving admission and discharge details of all the beneficiaries under treatment during the month in the following format:

- 5.5 Hospitals shall provide all necessary information for the purpose of settling bills expeditiously.
- 5.6 The Hospital shall along with the bill submit a Discharge Summary for each beneficiary containing the admission details, diagnosis, medical procedures and management, diagnosis test, etc.

# 6. RESPONSIBILITIES OF URSC

URSC shall endeavor to make all payments due to the Hospital/Diagnostic Centre within reasonable period.

# 7. CONTACT PERSONS

- 7.1 For U R Rao Satellite centre: Chief Medical Officer (CMO)
- 7.2 For Hospital: General Manager(GM)

# 8. NON ASSIGNMENT

- 8.1 The Hospital shall not assign, in whole or in part, its obligations to perform under the agreement, except with the prior written consent of URSC. Any such assignment shall not relieve the Hospital from any liability or obligation under this agreement.
- 8.2 For over-billing and unnecessary procedures, the extra amount so charged will be deducted from the pending / future bills of the Hospital and URSC shall have the right to issue a written warning to Hospital not to do so in future. The recurrence, if any will lead to the stoppage of referral to that Hospital.

#### 9. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 9.1 URSC may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Agreement, by written notice of default sent to the Hospital, terminated the Agreement in whole or part.
  - (a)If the Hospital fails to provide any or all of the service for which it has been recognized within the period (s) specified in the Agreement, or within any extension there of if granted by URSC pursuant to condition of Agreement
  - (b) If the Hospital fails to perform any other obligation (s) under the Agreement.
  - (c) If the Hospital, in the judgment of URSC has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Agreement.
- 9.2 If the Hospital found to be involved in or associated with any unethical illegal or Unlawful activities, the Agreement will be summarily suspended by URSC without any notice and thereafter may terminate the Agreement; after giving show cause notice and considering its reply if any, received within 10 days of the receipt of show cause notice.
- 9.3 In case of any violation of the provision of the Agreement by the Hospital such as a (but not limited to), refusal of service, refusal of credit facilities to eligible beneficiaries and direct charging from the beneficiary undertaking the unnecessary procedures, prescribing unnecessary drugs / tests, deficient of defective service, over billing and negligence in treatment, the URSC shall have the right to de-recognize the hospital as the case may be.

# 10 INDEMNITY

The Hospital shall at all times, indemnify and keep indemnify made against all action, suits claims and demands brought or done in the Hospital in execution of or in connection with the services under this Agreement and against any loss or damage to URSC/ the Government in consequence to any action or suit being brought against the CHSS/The Government along with (or otherwise) Hospital as a party for anything done in the course of execution of this Agreement. The Hospital all times abide by the job safety measure and other statutory requirements prevalent in URSC from all demands or responsibilities arising from accidents or loss of life, the cause or result of which is attributable the Hospital.

The Hospital will pay all indemnities arising from such incidents without any extra cost to URSC and will not hold URSC responsible or obligated. URSC may at its discretion and shall always be entirely at the cost of the Hospital defend such suit, either jointly with the Hospital or independently in case the latter chooses not to defend the case.

#### 11 RATES:

- 11.1 The Hospital shall be paid for the services rendered in terms of the Annexure to this contract.
- 11.2 The Hospital will be entitled to payment only in terms of the rates contained in the CHSS Schedule of Rates and no additional amount relating to consultation, cross-consultation, treatment, procedures, tests, operations or any other related matter shall be claimed in the bills submitted to URSC.
- 11.3 Diet charges are not admissible under the CHSS and should be claimed directly from the beneficiary.

- 11.4 All other miscellaneous charges like telephones calls, etc are not admissible under the CHSS and should be claimed directly from the beneficiary.
- 11.5 The charges for the operations listed in the schedule are inclusive of the Surgeon's fee, Anesthetist fee and operation theatre charges and the hospital shall not bill these items separately.
- 11.6 If, during an operation for the primary ailment, a second surgical procedure is to be undertaken as a part of the primary surgical procedure, the rate for second procedure will be limited to 50% of CHSS Schedule of Rates.

#### 12 PAYMENT:

- 12.1 The bills towards the treatment of beneficiaries are required to be submitted in prescribed format to the respective Accounts Officer as indicated in the <u>ANNEXURE</u>. A Xerox copy of CHSS card (both sides) may be enclosed.
- 12.2 The Hospital shall extend its services to the beneficiaries on credit basis and the beneficiaries shall not be made to pay any charges directly to the Hospital except for the charges mentioned in the clauses 12.3 & 12.4.

#### 13. ARBITRATION

If any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever (the decision is not herein otherwise provided for) arises between URSC and the Hospital / Diagnostic Centre upon or in relation to or in connection with or arising out of the Agreement, shall be referred to Controller, UR Rao Satellite Centre, Bangalore for arbitration who will give written award of his/her decision to the parties. The decision of the Controller (Arbitration) be final and binding. The provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall apply to the arbitration proceedings. The venue of the arbitration proceedings shall be decided by the Arbitrator.

### 14. MISCELLANEOUS

14.1 Nothing under this Agreement shall be construed as establishing or creating between the parties any relationship of Master and Servant or Principal and Agent between URSC and the Hospital.

a. The Hospital shall not represent or hold itself out as agent

of the URSC.

b. URSC will not be responsible in any way for any negligence or misconduct of the Hospital and its employees for any accident, injury or damage sustained or suffered by any beneficiary or any third party resulting from or by any operation conducted by and on behalf of the Hospital in particular where such change would have an impact on the performance of obligation under this Agreement.

c. This Agreement can be modified or altered only on written

agreement signed by both the parties.

d. Should the Hospital get wound up or partnership is dissolved, URSC shall have the right to terminate the Agreement and shall not relieve the hospital or their heirs or legal representatives from the liability in respect of the services provided by the Hospital during the period when the Agreement was in force.

# 15. OTHER GENERAL TERMS:

- 15.1 Dental treatment shall not be undertaken in the hospital unless it is required to be done as part of general surgical treatment or in the case of patients who have developed serious systemic diseases.
- 15.2 Treatment for infertility is not approved under the CHSS.
- 15.3 Treatment taken in branches of the Hospital will not be admissible for re-imbursement.
- 15.4 The recognition of the Hospital under the CHSS may be terminated by either party on one month's notice in writing.

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#### DISPUTES 16.

All disputes & differences, arising out of this agreement shall be settled mutually by the parties. If there is no settlement reached the matter shall be referred to the Arbitration.

#### INCOME TAX. 17.

Tax at Source as applicable will be deducted from time to time.

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

# 1. Roles and Responsibilities of the First Party:

# 2. Roles and Responsibilities of the Second Party:

- 2.4 Faculty, post graduate students and interns from Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences, Kumarswamy Layout Bangalore 560078, shall provide services to the patients on outpatient basis and will frame guidelines for the treatment of patients depending on the nature of illness. The treatment to such patients shall be as per Standard Treatment Guidelines.
- 2.5 The Second party agrees to provide free OPD Consultation as well as further management of patients.
- 2.6 The Second party shall ensure that the best and complete diagnostic, therapeutic and Follow-up services based on Standard protocol and Dental practices/ recommendations are extended to the beneficiary. It is also mandatory for the provider to assess the appropriate need and subject the beneficiary for treatment/procedure free of cost without causing any burden to First Party. The treatment will be followed as per guidelines from department of Health and Family welfare services. The Second party will be accountable/responsible for all the legal issues regarding the treatment and management of all dental and related procedures carried out by them in the Dental Unit.
  - 2.7 The Second Party agrees to render complete oral Health needs for all the beneficiaries who visits the facility which would include Oral screening, including Oral Screening in ANC, Oral prophylaxis, Restorations, extractions, IOPARs, and other necessary treatment including Dantha Bhagya Yojane.
  - 2.8 All the equipments, Instrument and logistics required will be borne by the Second Party.
  - 2.9 Second Party shall submit monthly reports in accordance with the Statement of Work in the prescribed format to First Party regularly.

#### 3. Standard Scope and Services:

3.1 Dental unit at PHC Konanakunte will be working on all the days of the Hospital Remits excluding Government holidays, Regular Outpatient services will be offered by the Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences. Kumarswamy Layout Bangalore 560078. A designated team of faculty, post graduate students and

- 3.5 Periodical updates to be communicated to the Deputy Director, Oral Health Policy and Dental Health office authorities on the functioning and status of Dental Unit.

#### 4. Duration of MoU:

4.1 The duration of this agreement shall be for 5 years/or till the faculty appointment are made from the Government, whichever is earlier and shall be renewed unless terminated within the terms of this agreement.

#### 5. General:

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- 5.1 Settlement of disputes:
  - 5.1.1 In case of dispute arising upon or in relation to or in connection with the agreement between the parties, which has been not been settled amicably in the first place, be referred to Principal Secretary to the government (Health and Family Welfare). Either party may refer the dispute to the Principal Secretary (Health and Family Welfare), who shall give a decision in writing within 30 days of reference of dispute or such extended time as may be deemed fit and proper.

Either party may refer a written decision of the Principal Secretary (Health and Family Welfare) to arbitration (Karnataka arbitration) if aggrieved. If neither party refers the disputes to arbitration within 30 days of the date of such decision, the decision of Principal Secretary

5.1.3 The arbitration shall be held in accordance with provision of the arbitration and conciliation Act 1996.

### 6. Third Party Rights

- 6.1 Nothing in this agreement shall be taken as granted in any rights explicitly or implicitly whether contractual or statutory other than Commissioner HFWs or Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences, Kumarswamy Layout Bangalore 560078.
- 6.2 On expiry of the validity of MoU, the access provided to Dental unit would be deactivated unless revived by Commissioner HFWs.

#### 7. Costing

- 7.1 PHC Konanakunte shall provide facilities in terms of consultation rooms with water and electricity connection for operation of Dental Services.
- 7.2 No Financial assistance shall be provided by DHO/Commissioner HFWs/PHC Konanakunte to Dayananda Sagar College Dental Sciences, Kumarswamy Layout Bangalore 560078.

### 8. Intellectual Property Rights

The Parties acknowledge that nothing in this MoU shall affect ownership of any intellectual property rights.

#### 9. Notice of Communication

- 9.1 No claim shall be preferred by Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences, Kumarswamy Layout Bangalore 560078 in any court or tribunal against Commissioner HFWs without giving 60 days' notice as contemplated in section 80 of CPC after the award of Arbitration
- 9.2 If at any time during the continuance of this MoU, the performance in whole or in part by any of the parties to any of the objectives under this MoU is prevented or delayed by reason of governmental decision, war, hostilities, act of a public enemy, civil commotion, fire, flood, explosion, epidemics, quarantine peputy Dire restrictions, disturbance in supplies from normally reliable source (including bytalth policy a pent not limited to electricity, water, fuel and the like) at it. not limited to electricity, water, fuel and the like), strike, lockout or other endth and Femily beyond the reasonable control of the party con "the Eventuality"), then notice of such eventuality shall be given by the affected party to the other parties within 15 days from the date of occurrence thereof.

#### 10. Termination.

Either party may at any time at its sole discretion giving 3 months prior notice may terminate this MoU. Upon termination the premises at PHC Konanakunte shall be returned back to PHC Konanakunte.

Upon termination of the contract, dental chairs, equipments, instruments and what all is provided, installed or stored by Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences would be taken back by Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences

#### 11. Indemnity

The Second party will be accountable/responsible for all the legal issues on account of bodily injury, death or damage to tangible personal property arising in favour of any person, corporation or other entity attributable to the negligence or willful default in performance or non-performance under this agreement including regarding the treatment and management of all dental and related procedures carried out by them in the Dental Unit.

#### 12. Amendments & Modifications







Principal, Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences, Shavige Malleshwara Hills, Kumaraswamy Layout, Bangalore 560078, herein after referred to as SECOND PARTY(Which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include their successors, executors, assigns and administrators) of other part.

#### WHEREAS

- 1. The first Party is a non-profit dedicated to helping those with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities.
- 2. The Second party is affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore, Karnataka and also recognized by Dental Council Of India, New Delhi and ISO 9001-2008 certified institution. Since its inception, the Department of Public Health Dentistry has been involved in the prevention of oral diseases, promotion of oral health to the under privileged and needy through various outreach activities and school health programmes both in urban and rural areas.

Faculty, PG students and interns from Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences shall provide services to the patients and will frame guidelines for the treatment of patients depending on the nature of illness. The treatment to such patients shall be as per the Standard Treatment Guidelines.
    - c. Second party shall ensure that best and complete diagnostic, therapeutic and follow up services based on standard protocol and dental practices or recommendations are extended to the beneficiary. It is also mandatory for the provider to assess the appropriate need and subject the beneficiary for treatment or procedure free of cost without causing any burden to the first party.
    - d. All the equipments, instruments and logistics required will be borne by the second party.

# 3. Duration of MOU

The duration of this agreement shall be for 5 years and shall be renewed unless terminated within the terms of this agreement.

# 4. Settlement of disputes

The arbitration shall be held in accordance with provision of the arbitration and conciliation act 1996.

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#### 5. Third party rights

Nothing in this agreement shall be taken as granted in any rights explicitly or implicitly whether contractual or statutory other than the head of Shrishti Special Academy or Principal Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences.

#### 6. Intellectual Property Rights

The parties acknowledge that nothing in this MOU shall affect ownership of any Intellectual Property Rights.

#### 7. Confidentiality

a) Both parties shall treat as strictly confidential and prevent disclosure there of all confidential information exchanged pertaining to the activities under this MOU between DSCDS and Shrishti Special Academy. Both parties shall or disclose or use such confidential information for any other party in any manner and shall use only such information for the purposes of this MOU.

#### 8) Termination:

- a) On non performance of the obligations as specified in this MOU, either parties shall be entitled to terminate this MOU for any such breach of the terms of the MOU remains uncured for a period of 30 working days from the date of the notice to cure such breach. For the purpose of this clause, any breach of the terms of the MOU shall be deemed to have taken place from the date of the receipt of written intimation that a claim of breach has been raised.
- b) Not withstanding anything contrary stated here in above, both parties shall have the right to terminate this MOU without assigning any reasons by giving 30 days written notice to other party

#### 9) Force Majeure:

a) Neither party shall be liable for any failure or delay in performance under this MOU to this extent the said failures or delays are proximately caused by causes beyond that parties reasonable control and occurring without its fault or negligence including without limitations performance failures of parties outside the control of the contracting party, acts of God, war, floods, earthquakes, strikes, lockouts, epidemics, riots, civil disturbance among others, provided that force majeure will apply only if the failure to perform could not be avoided by

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the exercise of due care by the party invoking this clause and such party does everything reasonably possible to resume its performance under this MOU.

B) A party affected by an event of force majeure shall give the other party written notice, with full details as soon as possible and in any event not later than 14 calendar dates of the occurrence of the cause relied upon. If force majeure applies, dates by which performance obligations are scheduled to be met will be extended for a period of time equal to the time lost due to any delay so caused.

However, if the performance of the MOU is delayed beyond 8 weeks from the date of this MOU, either party may at it's discretion terminate this MOU.

#### 10) General

- a) Severity: if any provision of this MOU is found by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid of un enforceable, the invalidity of such provision shall not affect the other provisions of the MOU and all provisions not affected by such invalidity shall remain in full force and effect.
- b) Waiver: the waiver by either party of a breach or default in any of the provisions of this MOU by the other party shall not be construed as a waiver of ant succeeding breach of the same or other provisions nor shall any delay or omission the part of either party to exercise or avail itself of any right, power or privilege operate as a waiver of any breach or default by the other party.
- C) Relationship: this MOU is being entered into on a principle-to-principle basis.
- D) Notices: any notice shall be given by a way of registered posts with acknowledgement due at the address given in the description of the parties. Email communications shall not be accepted as valid legal notices. The address and other details of the parties for the purpose of communication, unless otherwise notified in writing, to the other parties shall be as provided in this MOU.
- E) Binding nature and assignment:
- i) This MOU shall be binding upon and inure solely to the benefit of the parties here to and their successor and permitted assigns and nothing in this MOU shall confer upon any other person or entity any legal or equitable right, benefit or remedy of any nature whatsoever under or by reason of this MOU. Neither party shall have the power to assign or transfer this MOU without the prior, written consent of the other party.

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- ii) The MOU constitutes the entire MOU between the parties here to. There are no prior or contemporaneous, oral or written, representations, understandings or MOUs, which are not fully expressed in this MOU.
  - iii) Amendment no amendment, change order, waiver or discharge shall be valid unless it is in writing and signed by an authorized representative of the party against whom such amendment, change order, waiver or discharge is sought to been forced.
    - G) Limitation of liability: in no event shall either party be liable to the other party or any other entity for any kid of losses including any loss profits, or for any indirect, special, consequential or incidental damages arising out of this MOU. Under any cause of action, whether or not such party or its agents have been advised of the possibility of such damage.

### H) Dispute resolution:

- i) Any dispute or difference arising between the parties under this MOU or the implementation of the obligation arising there from shall be discussed mutually and resolved within a period of 30 days.
